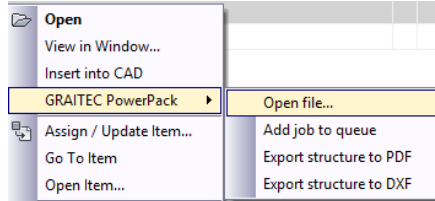


New Features

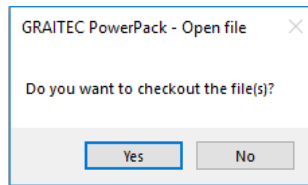
The **Update 1 to PowerPack for Vault 2021** includes the following new features:

The option to choose which program is used to open a file

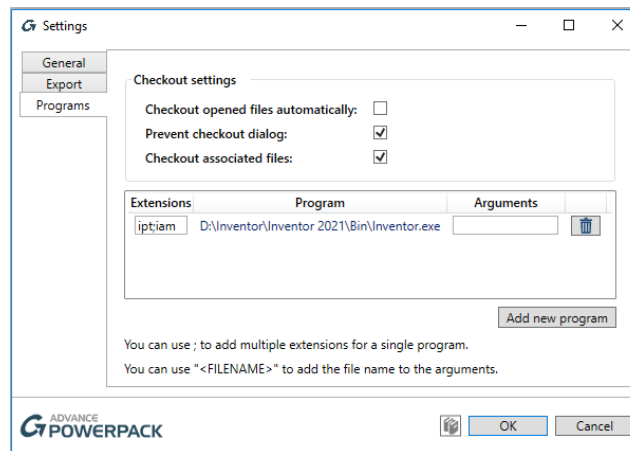
- Users can now select a non-default program to open a specific file in Vault Explorer;
- This command was added to the *GRAITEC PowerPack* context menu:



- The file is downloaded automatically from the Vault Server (if it does not exist on the local disk) and users can choose to checkout the file:

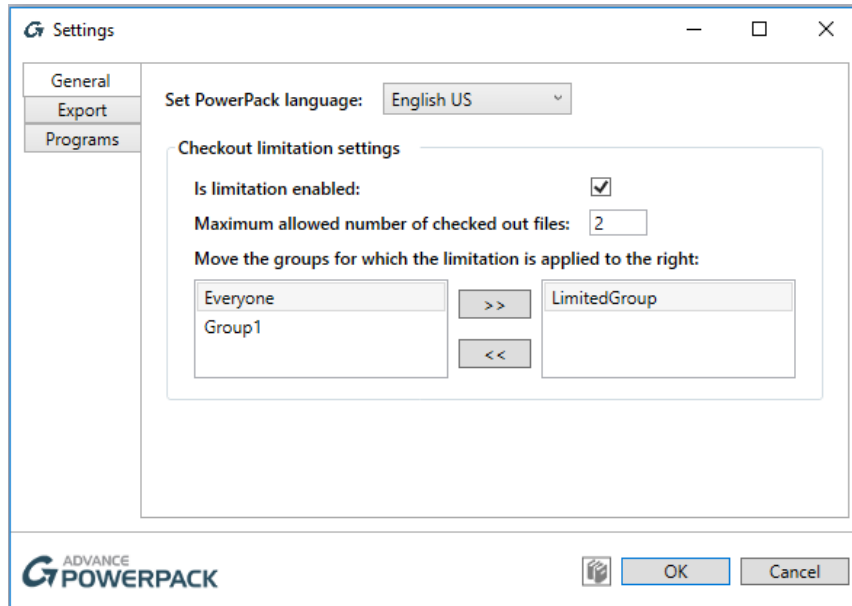


- The default application will be used in case there is no specified program for an extension;
- A new tab - *Programs* was created in the *PowerPack options* which allows users to:
 - Map applications to the desired extensions,
 - Launch a program using command-line arguments,
 - Checkout opened files automatically without showing the checkout dialog,
 - Prevent the checkout dialog from showing up,
 - Checkout associated files of the opened file.



Limited number of Checked Out files per user group

- Administrators of the Vault Server can now limit the number of files a group of users can have checked out at one time;
- Administrators can toggle the limitation on/off and also specify the number of checked out files per single user;
- The settings were added to the *General* tab of the *PowerPack options*:



- The settings are saved on the Vault Server by an administrator that has both *AdministratorUserRead* and *VaultSetOptions* permissions;
- The users must have the *FileCheckOut*, *VaultGetOptions* and *FileRead* permissions in order to apply the limitation.
